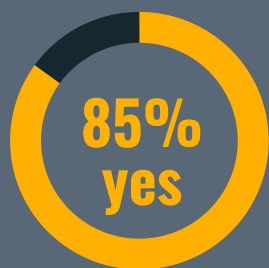




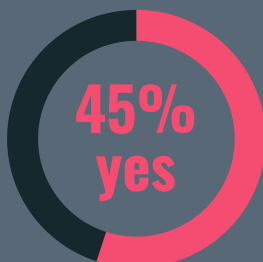

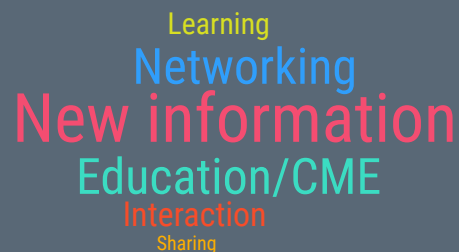
Typically attend national or international conferences?



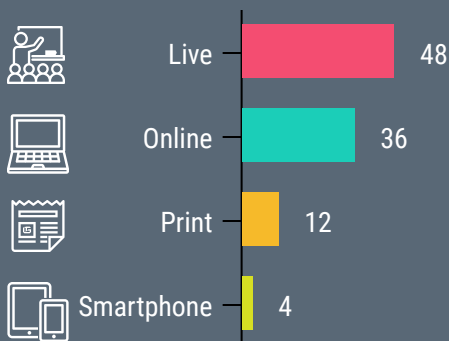
Are there national conferences that you will not be attending this year due to COVID-19?



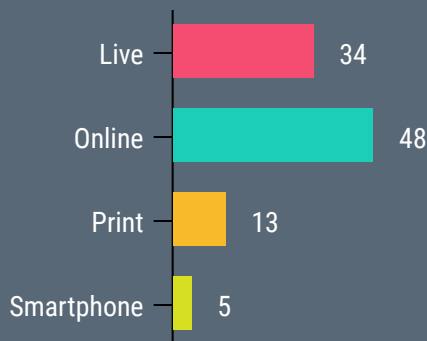
What will you miss out on most by not attending?



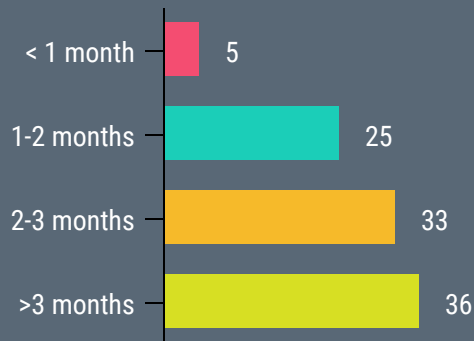
% of CME credits obtained in the past 12 months by format

I will shift my participation from live to online CME this spring to get the info I need

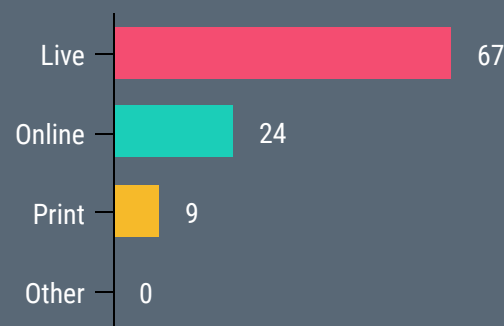


Agreement with Statement

CE Outcomes conducted a survey between March 14 - March 17 to assess the current impact of COVID-19 travel and personal interaction restrictions on their CME patterns and perceptions. The survey was fielded to US allergists, cardiologists, dermatologists, hematologic and medical oncologists, neurologists, and rheumatologists. A total sample of N=292 responses were collected.
