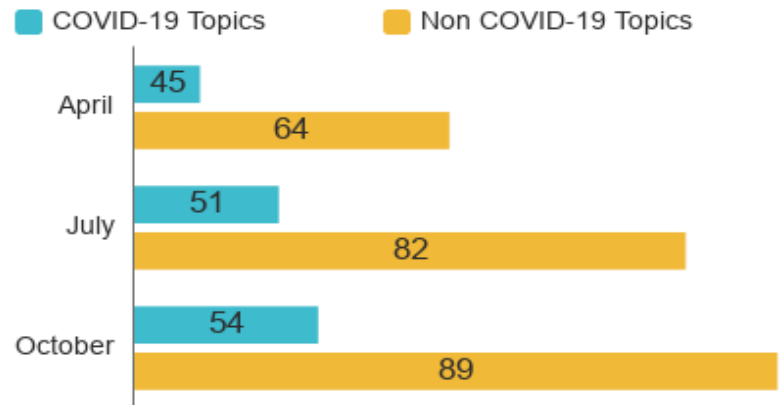


CME Engagement *and* Continued CME Needs on COVID-19

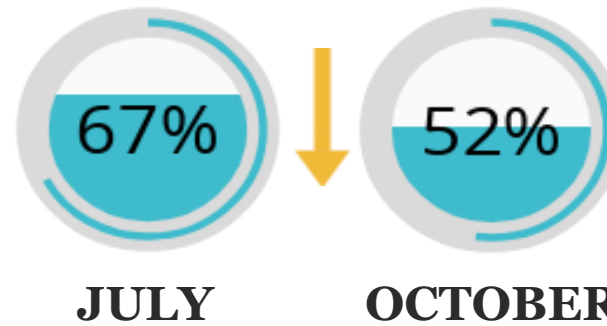
CME engagement over time

Relevance of COVID-19 CME

Fewer specialists reported content as very/extremely relevant to practice



While **54%** of specialists have participated in COVID-19 CME as of October, this is an increase of only **9%** since April.
